1. General Rules & Regulations

1.1. Overview

The Esports Nations Cup (ENC) is a biennial nation-based competition held in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. Unlike the club-focused Esports World Cup (EWC), the ENC focuses on national representation, where the world's elite players compete for their countries and territories.

1.3. Key Timelines

- **Coach Selection Deadline:** April 7, 2026 (11:59 PM AST).
- **Roster Submission Deadline:** May 10, 2026 (11:59 PM AST).
- **Main Event:** November 2 - November 29, 2026.

1.4. General Process

Rankings are used to determine Direct Invitations or Guaranteed Representation for countries/territories on each game title (with the exception of Counter Strike 2) at the Esports Nations Cup 2026. The process follows a three-step logic.

- **Club / Player Performance:** Every performance by clubs or players at designated "Contributing Competitions" is taken into account, and points are granted according to the point system of each applicable game title.
- **Point Distribution:** Points earned by a club are distributed among all players who participated in the competition and were listed on the active roster for that event. Substitutes do not receive points.
- **National Aggregate:** For all team-based titles, with the exception of Counter-Strike 2, Apex Legends, and Street Fighter 6, the National Game Coach submits a roster by the before mentioned deadline. The ENC then aggregates the individual points of the submitted players to produce the Ranking. The "best possible roster" for a country/territory is therefore the combination of eligible players that generates the highest total number of points.
 - In the event that two or more countries/territories are tied, the following tiebreakers will be applied:
 - Total points from highest-tier tournaments
 - Total points from next highest-tier tournaments
 - Highest individual player points

- Additional player-based comparisons (next highest player)
- Best individual event finish from highest-tier tournaments
- Number of ranked events with points
- Administrative decision (final tiebreak)

For solo titles, rankings are based on the individual performance of each player. Invitations are issued to the highest-ranked player from each country or territory, limited to one invited player per country or territory. However, up to two players from the same country or territory may qualify for the ENC Finals through the qualification process.

2. Game-Specific Ranking Methodology

Each game follows the standard four-part structure: Eligible Period, Point System, Player Contribution Model, and Contributing Competitions.

In events where specific ranking positions are contested and result in distinct placements (e.g., 5th–6th vs. 7th–8th), points shall be awarded based on the average value of the placement bracket.

- **Apex Legends**

Specifically for Apex Legends, the top 20 ranked countries/territories will receive a guaranteed representation, meaning that while these countries/territories are assured a place in the ENC Finals through the ranking system, the final roster representing each of them will still be determined via the open regional qualifiers.

- **Counter Strike 2**

The Counter-Strike 2 VRS ranking will be used to determine country/territory eligibility for the 96 available National Qualifiers, and to seed them at the ENC Finals. No country or territory will receive a direct invitation to the Finals.

In the event that the VRS ranking (and its players) contains less than 96 countries/territories, an additional ranking will be established based on the sum of the FACEIT ELO of the top 40 active players from each country or territory not part of the VRS ranking, measured during the full month of May.

For clarity, any country or territory represented in the VRS ranking will always be ranked above those ranked solely via FACEIT ELO.
